Structural Ingenuity

Entry achieves structural goals either in a creative manner or at an extraordinary scale.

Structural goals are ambitious and daring.

- 1/4-inch thick foam-core, cardboard, masonite, plywood, or plexiglass may be used for leveling materials. However, the use of leveling materials is discouraged for this category! If leveling materials are used, it is preferable that leveling materials are not visible. Leveling items are different than structural support. If its clear the cans would fall without the support, then its structural and not leveling.
- "Hollow" structures do not use internal supports, frames, or forms
- Appears to defy gravity but is stable.
- High level of difficulty.

Best Original Design

- Structures that are obviously not self-supporting. For example: a material that is not on the allowable items list (i.e. plexiglass) is used to span a gap.

Best Use of Labels

- Items other than labels used for appearance of structure (i.e. colored paper).

Structural Ingenuity

- Structures that are obviously not self-supporting. For example: a material that is not on the allowable items list (i.e. plexiglass) is used to span a gap.
